DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

7 5/8" seamless casing had been set @ 3459' and cemented w/ 50 sacks of common cement. The well was allowed to stand undisturbed for a period of 72 hours. 1200# pressure was then applied to the pipe and fittings, the valves closed, and the pressure within observed for a period of thirty minutes. There was no drop in pressure. The cement plug was then drilled and the same test again applied. Again there was no drop in pressure.

Drilling was resumed on the night of December 24, 1938.
