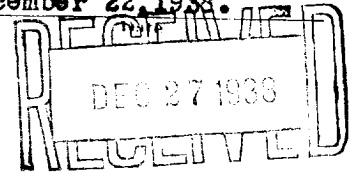

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

At TD 3465', 7 5/8" OD seamless casing has been set @ 3459' and cemented with 50 sacks of common cement. The plug was pumped to 3366' @ 6 p.m. 12-21-38.

The well will be allowed to stand undisturbed for a period of 72 hours. The pipe and fittings will then be tested by applying pump pressure of 1200#, the valves closed, and the pressure within observed for a period of thirty minutes. If there is no drop in pressure, the cement plug will then be drilled and the same test again applied. If there is no drop in pressure, drilling will be resumed on the evening of December 24, 1938.
