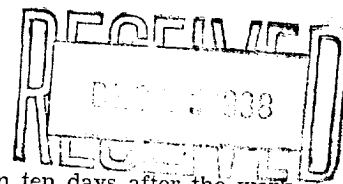

## MISCELLANEOUS REPORTS ON WELLS

It should be signed and sworn to before a notary public for reports on beginning drilling operations, results of shooting well, results of test of casing shut-off, result of plugging of well, and other important operations, even though the work was witnessed by an agent of the Commission. Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public. See additional instructions in the Rules and Regulations of the Commission.

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

As reported, 9 5/8" casing was set @ 2983' and cemented with 500 sacks of common cement @ 9:30 a.m. December 16, 1938.

The well was allowed to stand undisturbed for a period of 72 hours. Pump pressure of 1200# was then applied to the pipe and fittings, the valves closed and the pressure within the pipe and fittings observed for a period of 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. The cement plug was then drilled and the same test again applied and there was no drop in pressure. Drilling was resumed on the morning of December 18, 1938.
