As reported, 9 5/8" casing was set @ 2983' and comented with 500 sacks of common coment 9;30 a.m. December 15,1938.

The well was allowed to stand undisturbed for a period of 72 hours. Fump pressure of 1200# was then applied to the pipe and fittings, the values closed and the pressure within the pipe and fittings observed for a period of 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. The cement plug was then drilled and the same test again ar plied and there was no drop in pressure. Drilling was resumed on the morning of December 18,1938.
