FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well has been drilled to a total depth of 2995'. ϕ 5/8" OD seamless casing has been set @ 2985' and cemented with 500 sacks of common cement. The plug was pumped to 2920' @ 9:30 a.m. December 15, 1938.

The well will be allowed to stand undisturbed for a period of 72 hours. After this time, pump pressure of 1200# will be applied to the pipe and fittings, the valves closed, and the pressure within the pipe and connections observed for a period of 30 minutes. If there is no drop in pressure, the cement plug will then be drilled and the same test again applied to the pipe and fittings. If there is no drop in pressure, drilling will be resumed on the morning of December 18, 1938.
