Total Depth 290' Redbeds.

With 13" OD casing set @ 281' and cemented with 250 sacks of common cement at 11 p.m. on November 29, 1938, the well will be allowed to stand undisturbed for a period of 48 hours. The cement plug will then be drilled and the hole bailed dry. The well will be allowed to stand undisturbed for another hour and the bailer run again to determine if any water has accumulated. If no water is present, drilling will be resumed.
