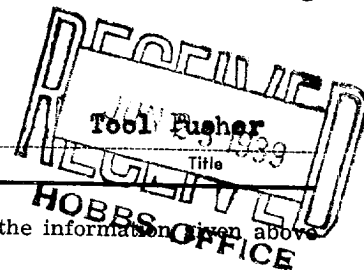

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

TD 3115'. 8 5/8" OD seamless casing was set @ 3104' and cemented with 500 sacks. The well was allowed to stand undisturbed for a period of 72 hours. The pipe and connections were tested with 1200# pump pressure, the valves closed, and the pressure within observed for a period of 30 minutes. The cement plug was then drilled and the same test again applied. There was no drop in pressure in either instance. Drilling was resumed on the morning of June 18, 1939.
