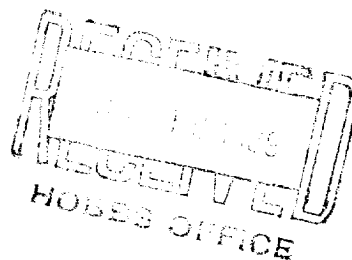

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well has been drilled to TD 3115. On June 14th., 9 5/8" casing was set @ 3104' and cemented with 500 sacks of common cement. The plug was pumped to 3081'. We propose to allow the well to stand undisturbed for a period of 72 hours. Pump pressure of 1200# will then be applied to the pipe and fittings, the valves closed, and the pressure within observed for a period of 30 minutes. If there is no drop in pressure, the plug will be drilled and the same test again applied to determine the shut off. If there is no drop in pressure, drilling will be resumed on the night of June 17, 1939.
