DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

With TD 310' and 13" Casing set @ 297' with 250 sacks of common cement circulated to the cellar @ 6:30 p.m. 6-4-39, the well was allowed to stand undisturbed for a period of 48 hours. The cement plug was then drilled and the hole bailed dry. Operations were shut down for one hour and the bailer again run to determine if there was water present. There was none.

Drilling was resumed on the night of June 6, 1939.
