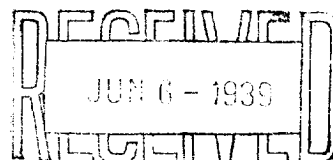

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This hole has been drilled to a total depth of 310'. The formation @ TD 310' is redbed. 13" OD 50# Casing was set @ 297' and cemented with 250 sacks of common cement. The cement was circulated to the bottom of the cellar. Cementing was completed June 4, 1939, at 6:30 p.m.

It is proposed to allow the well to stand undisturbed for a period of 48 hours, after which well connections will be made. The cement plug will then be drilled, and the hole bailed dry to determine if there is water present. After bailing dry, the hole will be allowed to remain undisturbed for a period of one hour, after which the bailer will again be run to determine the effectiveness of water shut off. If there is no water present, drilling will be resumed on the night of June 6th., 1939, or shortly thereafter.
