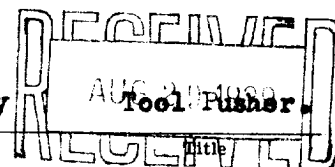
DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

With the well standing cemented @ TD 3110'; 8 5/8" Casing @ 3100'; cemented w/ 250 sacks, on August 23, 1939, the well was allowed to stand undisturbed for a period of 72 hours. Pump pressure of 1200# was applied to the pipe and fittings, the valves closed, and the pressure within observed for a period of 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. The cement plug was ~~sg~~ then drilled and the same test again applied without a drop in pressure. Drilling was resumed on the evening of August 26, 1939.
