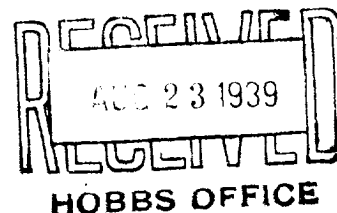

## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well has been drilled to TD 325'. 13" Casing was set @ 314' and cemented with 250 sacks of common cement, and the plug pumped to 300' @ 3 p.m. 8/12/39. We propose to allow this well to stand undisturbed for a period of 48 hours. After which time the cement plug will be drilled and the hole bailed dry. After waiting one hour, the bailer will again be run to determine the water shut off. If there is no water present, drilling will be resumed.
