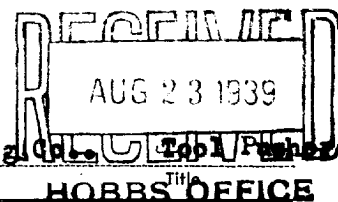

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

With 15" OD Casing set @ 314' and cemented with 250 sacks, the well was allowed to stand undisturbed for a period of 48 hours. The plug was then drilled and the hole bailed dry. Operations were shut down for one hour. The bailer was again run to bottom to determine if there was water present. There was none. Drilling was resumed August 14, 1939.
