DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

@ TD 3115' 8 5/8" Seamless casing was set @ 3109' and cemented with 50 sacks of Incoor and 200 Sacks of common cement.

The pipe and connections were tested by applying pump pressure of 1200#, the valves closed and the pressure observed for a period of 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. The cement plug was then drilled and the same test again applied without drop in pressure. Drilling was resumed on the evening of September 29, 1939.
