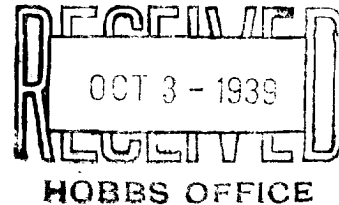
Following is a notice of intention to do certain work as described below at the Amerada Petroleum Corporation State LA Well No. 4 in C of NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 17s, T. 36e, R. South Lovington, N. M. P. M., Lea County.

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well has been drilled to TD 3115'. 8 5/8" seamless casing has been set @ 3109' and cemented with 250 sacks of cement, of which 50 sacks were Incor and the balance Lone Star Common. The plug was pumped to 3060'.

We propose to test the pipe and connections with 1200# pump pressure, to close the valves and observe the drop in pressure within. If there is no drop, the cement plug will be drilled and the same test again applied. If there is no drop in pressure drilling will be resumed September 29, 1939.
