DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

With 5 1/2" seamless casing set at 4579' and cemented with 200 sacks ~~monument~~ El Toro common cement and 20 sacks of El Toro Special cement, the well was allowed to stand undisturbed for a period of 72 hours. Pump pressure of 1800# was then applied to the pipe and fittings, the valves closed and the pressure observed for a period of 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. The cement plug was then drilled and the same test ~~applied~~ again applied. There was no drop in pressure and drilling was resumed.
