DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

With 8 5/8" Casing set @ 3091' and cemented with 200 sacks of El Toro common cement and 50 sacks of El Toro special cement, the well was allowed to stand undisturbed for a period of 72 hours. Pump pressure of 1200# was then applied to the pipe and fittings, the valves closed and the pressure observed for a period of 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. The cement plug was then drilled and the same test again applied. There was no drop in pressure. Drilling was resumed.
