DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well had been drilled to a TD of 4595'. 5 1/2" CD 17# seamless casing had been set @ 4589' and cemented with 150 Sacks of El Toro common cement and 50 sacks of Quickset cement. The plug was pumped to 4523'.

Pump pressure of 1200# was applied to the pipe and connections the valves closed and the pressure within observed for a period of 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. The cement plug was then drilled and the same test again applied without drop in pressure.

Drilling was resumed December 30, 1939.
