## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

With the well drilled to a TD of 3109' and 7 5/8" seamless casing set @ 3099' and cemented with 215 sacks of common and 50 sacks of Quickset cement, pump pressure of 1200# was applied to the pipe and connections, the valves closed and the pressure within observed for a period of 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. The cement plug was then drilled and the same test again applied and again there was no drop in pressure. Drilling was resumed.
