## This well has been drilled to TD 3109'.

7 5/8" seamless casing has been set @ 3099' and cemented with 215 sacks of El Toro common cement and 50 sacks of El Toro Quickset cement. The plug was pumped to 3069', @ 10 a.m. December 16, 1939.

We propose to allow this well to stand undisturbed for a period of 72 hours. After the waiting period, we propose to apply 1200# pump pressure to the pipe and connections, to close the valves, and observe the pressure for 30 minutes. If there is no drop in pressure, the cement plug will then be drilled and the same test again applied. If there is no drop in pressure, drilling will be resumed.
