DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

With the well drilled to TD 309' and 10 3/4" casing set @ 303' and cemented with 180 sacks of Trinity common cement, the well was allowed to stand undisturbed for a period of 72 hours. The cement plug was then drilled and the hole bailed dry. The well was then allowed to stand undisturbed for a period of 1 hour and then the bailer was again run to determine if there was water present. There was none. Drilling was resumed.
