This well has been drilled to TD 309'.

10 3/4" Casing has been set @ 303' and cemented with 180 sacks of Trinity cement.
 The plug was pumped to 288' @ 5 p.m. December 8, 1939.

We propose to allow the well to stand undisturbed for a period of 72 hours, after which time the cement plug will be drilled and the hole bailed dry. After bailing dry, the well will be allowed to stand for 1 hour, after which the bailer will again be run to determine if there is water present. If no water has accumulated, drilling will be resumed.
