FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well has been drilled to a Total Depth of 3102'.

Set 7-5/8" BEPE 22.05# Casing at 3092', cemented with 250 sacks of El Toro and
50 sacks of Incor Cement. Plug was pumped to 3048' at 1 A.M. 11-12-41.

We propose to let this well stand undisturbed for a period of 72 hours. After
the waiting period, we propose to apply 1200# pump pressure to the pipe and
connections, to close the valves, and observe the pressure for 30 minutes. If
there is no drop in pressure, the cement plug will then be drilled and the same
test again applied. If there is no drop in pressure, drilling will be resumed.
