## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

6240' Total Depth. Line. Finished drilling 7-7/8" hole @ 6:19 PM, 8/18/53. Ran a total of 200 Jts of 5-1/2" OD casing set @ 6015' W/550 sx. Pumped Plug to 5947'. Max pressure 2100#. Ran temperature survey - top of cement 3724' or 78.8% fill. After 24 hours tested 5-1/2" casing W/800# - no pressure drop. Drilled cement from 5947' to 6015' and washed to bottom at 6240'. (Open hole from 6015' to 6240'). Continued with completion operations -
