DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

3750' - T.D. Lime - Finished drilling 11" hole to 3750' at 8:15 PM, 8/1/53 - Ran a total of 94 Jts of 8-5/8" OD Casing set @ 3723' w/1500 sacks cement. Pumped plug to 3649' @ 2 PM, 8/2/53 - Max. pressure 1100#. Cement did not circulate - Ran temperature survey - Top of cement outside 8-5/8" casing @ 390', or, 57.1% fill. After WOC for 24 hours, tested casing for 1/2 hour with 900# - no pressure drop. Drilled cement from 3649' to 3723 & tested 8-5/8" casing for 1/2 hour with 900# - OK. Washed open hole from 3723' to 3750. Started drilling 7-7/8" hole from 3750 @ 6:15 AM, 8/4/53 -
