6235' T.D. - Line. Finished drilling 7-7/8" hole @ 11:30 PM, 9/21/53. Ran a total of 201 Jts of 5-1/2" OD casing set @ 6030' with 550 sacks cement. Pumped plug to 5970' @ 2:15 PM, 9/22/53 - Max pressure, 1400#. Ran temperature survey - top of cement outside 5 1/2" casing, at 3712', or 65.2% fill. After WOC for 24 hours, tested casing with 1000# for 1/2 hour - No pressure drop. Drilled cement from 5970' to 6030' and washed to bottom @ 6235'. Continued with completion operations -
