

I, John M. Kelly, Engineer for the Proration Office of Lea County, do hereby certify that on the 20th day of January, 1939 did make a test of a gas well located in Section 1, Township 17 South, Range 36 East known as the Stanolind No. 1 State. This test was made as follows;


The well was blown to the air for a period of 4 hours; from 10:20AM to 2:20PM, before any measurement was taken. At 2:20PM this well measured 6,850,000 cubic feet of gas per 24 hours.

This well is furnishing gas for three oil field boilers. Shut in pressure of well after the above test measured 1650 pounds per square inch.

The above measurement does not reflect the actual size of the gas well, nor does it reflect the well's ability to produce over a long period, but merely indicates, in the opinion of the undersigned, that the well is a commercial well from the standpoint of gas production.
