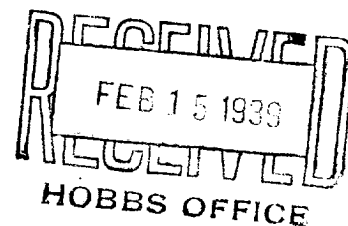

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

At 11:30 AM February 15th, 48 hours will have elapsed since setting 15" OD casing, landed at 299' and cemented with 200 sax. At this time we plan to test this casing as follows: Build up 1000# pressure, close valves and hold for 30 minutes. If okay, drill plug and again build up 1000# pressure, close valves and hold for 30 minutes. If this test okay, drilling will be resumed.
