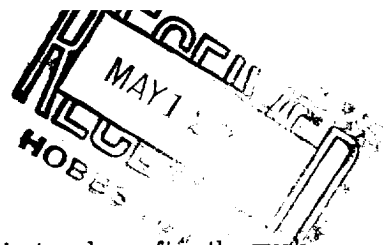

On March 30, 1947, workover operations were started. After pulling tubing the Dowell Spinner was run and permeable zones were found at 4640-45, 4831-33, and 4875-80. Ran radioactive log, then perforated formation 4650-60, 4666-71, 4676-87, 4702-12, 4796-4804, 4812-18, 4914-32, 4936-42, 4946-50 with 4 shots per foot. Well was cleaned out to bottom and acidized with 1000 gallons from 4911-52 using electric pilot. Spent acid was swabbed off. Well was then plugged back with Ottawa sand and jel seal to 4818 and acidized with 2000 gallons 4818-4658 using electric pilot. Cleaned out to bottom, reran tubing and swabbed. On April 13, well flowed 14 BO in 24 hours then died. On April 17, flowed 14½ BO in 7 hours then died. Workover was unsuccessful in that it will be necessary to install pumping equipment.
