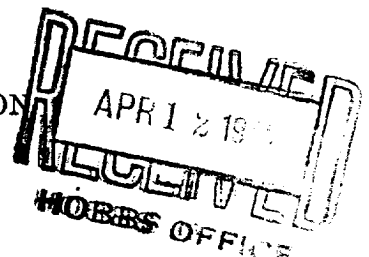

Total Depth 4960. 5½" Casing set at 4541'. Well flows only 20 BOPD and recently it has been dying frequently. We propose to run Dowell Spinner to locate permeable zones, and also run radioactive survey. Secondary zones will then be perforated with 4 shots per foot and selectively acidized to increase oil production.
