## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 12:00 noon December 1, 72 hours had elapsed since setting 5 1/2" casing at 4556' with 300 sacks cement. At this time we tested shutoff in the following manner:

Built up pressure to 1000#, closed valves and held for 30 minutes. Drilled plug, again built up pressure to 1000#, closed valves and held for 30 minutes. Test was OK, and drilling was resumed.
