At 12:00 noon December ~~last~~ 1st, 72 hours will have elapsed since setting 5 1/2" casing at 4556' with 300 sacks cement. At this time we propose to test shutoff in the following manner:

Build up pressure to 1000#, close valves and hold for 30 minutes. Drill plug, again build up pressure to 1000#, close valves and hold for 30 minutes. If test is OK, drilling will be resumed.

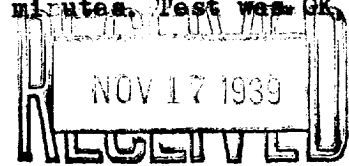

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 8:00 A.M. November 16, 72 hours had elapsed since setting 8-5/8" casing at 3140' with 500 sacks cement. At this time we tested shutoff in the following manner:

Built up pressure to 1000#, closed valves and held for 30 minutes. Drilled plug, again built up pressure to 1000#, closed valves and held for 30 minutes. Test was OK, and drilling was resumed.
