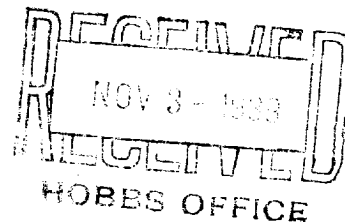

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

At 1:30 P.M. November 3rd, 48 hours will have elapsed since setting 13" casing at 298' with 200 sacks cement. At this time we plan to test shutoff as following:

Bail hole dry and allow to stand for two hours. Drill plug, again bail hole dry and allow to stand for two hours. If test is OK, drilling will be resumed.
