DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 1:30 p. m., June 7th., 1941, 72 hours had elapsed since setting 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing at 4546 and cementing with 350 sacks cement.

At this time, we tested this shut off by building up 1000# pressure and holding for 30 minutes. Test was okay; plug was drilled and 1000# pressure again built up and held for 30 minutes.

Tests were okay, drilling resumed.
