DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 12:30 A. M., May 18th, 1941, 72 hours had elapsed since setting 8-5/8" OD casing at 2038' and cementing with 600 sacks cement on the above location. At that time, casing was tested in the following manner:

1000# pressure built up and held for 30 minutes. Test was okay, plug was drilled.
1000# pressure built up again and held for 30 minutes. This test was okay, too, and drilling was resumed.
