Gentlemen:

During the casing leak survey of the Lovington field in June 1957 Mr. E. Engbrecht of the Hobbs OCC office found the following condition existed at subject well:

<u>ANNULUS</u>	<u>PRESSURE, psig.</u>
13" x 8 5/8"	5
8 5/8" x 5 1/2"	5
5 1/2" x 2"	100
2"	100

On venting the 5 1/2" x 8 5/8" annulus to zero gauge pressure the 8 5/8" x 13" annulus decreased to zero during the same time interval. The OCC, therefore, must assume that a leak exists in the 8 5/8" casing.

You are hereby directed to contact the Commission office in Hobbs to outline a program (C-102) for further testing or remedial work to correct this situation.
