## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 9:45 AM, August 6th, 1941, 78 hours had elapsed since ~~beginning~~ setting 8-5/8" OD casing at 2050' and cementing with 600 sacks cement on above location. At that time, casing was tested in the following manner:

1000# pressure built up and held for 30 minutes. Test was okay so plug was drilled. 1000# pressure built up again and held for 30 minutes. This test was okay, too, and drilling was resumed.
