## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 8:00 P. M. January 11, 1942, 72 hours had elapsed since setting 5-1/2" OM casing at 4590' with 380 sacks of cement.

At this time, we tested this shut off by building up 1000# pressure and holding for 30 minutes. Test was okay; plug was drilled and 1000# pressure again built up and held for 30 minutes.

Tests were okay. Drilling resumed.
