DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 12:00 O'clock midnight, January 25, 1943, 48 hours had elapsed since setting 8-5/8" OD intermediate casing @ 2051' with 600 sacks of cement.

At this time, the casing was tested in the following manner:

Built up 1000# pressure and held for 30 minutes. Tested OK and plug was drilled. Again built up 1000# pressure and held for 30 minutes. This test, too, was OK and drilling operations was then resumed.
