DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 6:00 P.M. January 14, 1943, 48 hours had elapsed since setting 13" O.D. casing at 250', and cementing w/ 175 sacks. At that time 13" casing was tested in the following manner: 800# was built up and allowed to stand 30 minutes. Test was O.K. and plug was drilled. 800# was again built up and held for 30 minutes. This test was O.K. too, and drilling was resumed.
