DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 4:00 AM, June 12, 1943, 76 hours had elapsed since setting 5 1/2" OD oil casing string @ 4602' with 400 sacks of cement. At this time, the casing was tested, in the following manner:

1000# pressure built up and held for 30 minutes,. Tested OK, plug was then drilled and 1000# pressure was again built up and held for 30 minutes. This test, too, was OK. Drilling was then resumed.
