DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 5 AM April 29, 1943, 36 hours had elapsed since setting 13" OD surface casing @ 267' with 175 sacks cement. At this time, the casing was tested in the following manner: 1000 # pressure built up and held for 30 minutes. Tested OK, plug was then drilled and 1000# pressure was again built up and held for 30 minutes. This test, too, was OK. Drilling was then resumed.
