FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

The subject well was drilled to a total depth of 5152' in Anhydrite and 5½" OD 14# GH-40 SS Casing string was run and set at 4658' with 375 sacks of cement on October 3, 1944 at 5:30 P.M. On October 5, 5:30 P. M. 48 hours will have elapsed since setting surface casing, and we plan to test casing shut off in the following manner:

Build up 1000# pressure and hold for thirty (30) minutes, if test is Ok, plug will be drilled; after which pressure will again be built up to 1000# and held for thirty (30) minutes, if this test, too, is OK drilling operations will be resumed.
