DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 5:00 P.M., July 23rd, 50 hours had elapsed since setting 260" or 15" OD Surface Casing which was tested as follows: A pressure of 1000# was built up and held for 30 minutes, after which the cement plug was drilled and casing shut-off, was again tested by building up 1000# pressure and held for 30 minutes. As both tests proved satisfactory, drilling operations were resumed.
