A Sweet anchor type packer was set at 4876. A Jelly seal plug was placed from PBTD 5020' to 4985'. The interval below the packer (4876-4985') was treated with 3,000 gallons and the interval above the packer (4876-4680') was treated with 5,000 gallons 15% regular acid.
