DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On January 6, 1944, this well was acidized with 6,000 gallons of acid from 4760' to 5109', in an effort to stimulate oil and gas production. The results were as follows:

After swabbing spent water and sludge from hole through 2" tubing, well swabbed and flowed 35 barrels of oil plus 35 barrels of acid water in four hours through 2" tubing on January 12, 1945.
