DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 7:00 A. M. December 11, 1944, 72 hours had elapsed since setting 5½" OD New 14# Casing at 4674' with 400 sacks of cement. Casing shut off was tested in the following manner: A pressure of 1250 pounds was built up and held for 30 minutes. Casing shut-off was OK. So the cement plug was drilled and a pressure of 1250 lbs. was again built up and this test, too, was OK. Completion operations were resumed.
