FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We propose to acidize the subject well in two stages, using 1500 and 3500 gallons acid in an effort to stimulate oil and gas production. This well was completed February 19, 1945 at a total depth of 5120', and on Initial Potential test flowed 145 BO in sixteen hours natural, on 23/64" choke. Due to the decline in gas production, well will no longer flow.
