DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 6:30 p.m., January 28, 1945, 96 hours had elapsed since setting 4655' of 5 1/8" OD 14# New Seamless Casing and cemented with 400 sacks to be used as oil string. Casing was tested as follows:

Pressure of 750# was built up and held for 30 minutes; as this test was okeh, cement plug was drilled and a pressure of 750# was again built up and held for 30 minutes. This test, too, was okeh and drilling operations were resumed.
