FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

At 5:00 PM January 3, 1945, 48 hours will have elapsed since setting 2001' of 8-5/8" OD 32# SH Seamless casing and cementing with 600 sacks to be used as salt string; at this time we propose to test casing as follows:

Build up a pressure of 1000# and hold for thirty minutes. If this test is OK, the cement plug will be drilled and a pressure of 1000# again built up and held for thirty minutes. If this test, too, is OK, drilling operations will be resumed.
